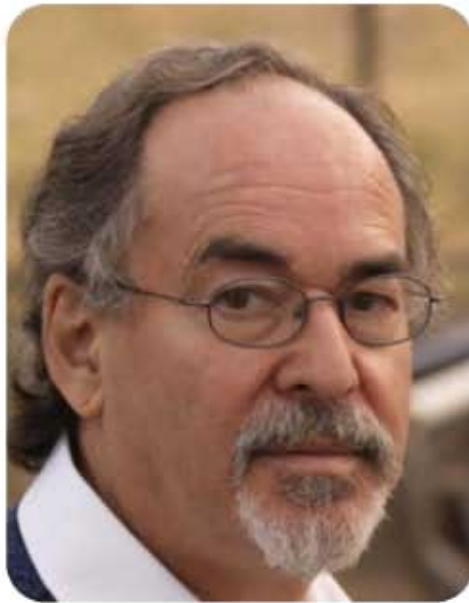

David Horowitz

Horowitz has devoted much of his attention over the past several years to the radicalization of the American university. In 2003, he launched an academic freedom campaign to return the American university to traditional principles of open inquiry and to halt indoctrination in the classroom. Horowitz has chronicled the

radicalization of the American university and the way indoctrination has replaced education in four books: *Uncivil Wars* (2003); *The Professors: the 101 Most Dangerous Academics in America* (2006); *Indoctrination U.* (2008); *One Party Classroom* (2009) and most recently *Reforming Our Universities* (2010).

His *Art of Political War* (2000) was described by White House political strategist Karl Rove as "the perfect guide to winning on the political battlefield." *Unholy Alliance* (2004) was a prophetic work pioneering the view that the Islamo Fascists are working hand in glove with the secular left. David Horowitz has spoken at over 300 colleges and universities and continues to visit more than 30 campuses a year. He has appeared on *Nightline*, *Crossfire*, *Today*, *Hannity and Colmes*, the *O'Reilly Factor*, *Good Morning America*, *C-SPAN*, *CNBC*, *Fox News Channel* and *MSNBC*.

TROOP PACKING PARTY PACKED

MALIBU—115 volunteers packed the Point Dume Club on Tuesday the 24th, busily volunteering their hearts out to honor our nation's servicemen and servicewomen at the annual Troop Packing Party hosted by the Malibu/Bel-Air Republican Women Federated. We salute Deborah Miller for making the clubhouse available to us! The fruit of volunteers' diligence included +2,600 care packages and hundreds of handwritten cards sent to the crew of the USS John Paul Jones, a guided missile destroyer currently guarding the Strait of Hormuz that made the first port call by a US Navy warship in the history Malibu last June. As the mellow Beach Boys tunes rang through the air, the volunteers hummed away like clockwork making care packages that included a carefully-balanced selection of small toys, darling handwritten letters, personal care items, sweet treats, and savory snacks like tender beef jerky and protein bars. Each package included a thank you hero card written by a student at Webster Elementary, Juan Cabrillo, or Berkeley Hall School, a school that also contributed over 100 Prayer Squares.

"We had an unprecedented level of enthusiastic community support," said capable event coordinator, Cindy Linke, Vice President of Americanism for the Malibu/Bel-Air Republican Women Federated. Support included everyone from Pepperdine basketball, water polo, and volleyball athletes to Mayor Laura Rosenthal who said, "I was honored to join fellow Malibuites in such a worthy cause. It was wonderful to see all ages there - from school children to seniors - helping to make the daily lives of our real heroes, our troops, better with their letters and care packages." Thanks to the wonderful and dedicated organizers and volunteers. First time volunteers included the Point Dume Girl Scouts who contributed three boxes of letters and packages and the Boys and Girls Club of Malibu who wrote troop support letters. Volunteer Chef John Linke made assorted culinary delights of fruit platters, stuffed tomatoes, enchiladas, and a shrimp butter dip. "America's soldiers and sailors put their lives on the line each day to defend our liberty," Cindy Linke said, "this is the least we can do to show our support for their fearless dedication and bravery."

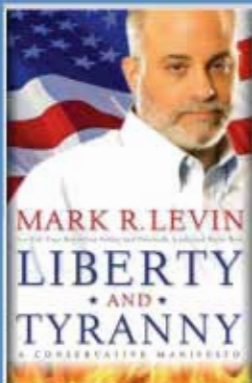
