I recently had the privilege of meeting Carly Fiorina, who recently announced [her](#) candidacy for president. 



For the June book recommendation, One of our founders, John Adams, a devout Christian, said, “Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious people, it is wholly inadequate to the government of any other.”
