Dr. Scott Lively is an attorney, pastor and international lecturer on the global LGBT agenda from a pro-family perspective. His quarter-century of activism and scholarship against that agenda has played a significant role in the culture war, earning him the designation of Public Enemy #1 by the world's largest homosexual advocacy group, the Human Rights Campaign.

His 1995 history text, *The Pink Swastika: Homosexuality in the Nazi Party* (now nearing its 5th edition), co-authored by Orthodox Jewish researcher Kevin E. Abrams, forced the LGBT movement to abandon its then two-decade-long campaign to fabricate a "Gay Holocaust" (equivalent to that of the Jews), along with its use of the pink triangle as the symbol of both that campaign and the movement itself. The title of his most recent book *Redeeming the Rainbow: A Christian Response to the "Gay" Agenda* references the rainbow symbol the movement was forced to switch to.

Dr. Lively and his wife, Anne are currently spending the winter in Riverside, CA with their grandchildren and planning a tour of Eastern Europe in 2016 to urge those still family-friendly nations to adopt the Russian anti-propaganda law and thereby create international pressure for a roll-back of the global LGBT agenda. Domestically, his emphasis is on strengthening the Christian church against so-called "Gay Theology," a far greater threat than is commonly recognized.

President's Message

Dear Members and Associates,



The political madness of 2015 was a prelude to the political drama to be played out in 2016. It was a forgettable year (the kind you *want* to forget, not the kind you can), the year House Speaker John Boehner tearfully (how else?) surrendered his leadership mantle under duress, only to be replaced by his Mini-Me, Paul Ryan.

Political infighting within the GOP exposed a deep schism between the old school and the new school, K Street and Tea Party, "moderates" and "extremists." Yet undeniably, any one of the GOP candidates is more suited to the office of president than a woman who can't even spell the word "truth."

We are an organization of politically conscious women marching to a different drumbeat than the presumptive female Democrat nominee. She does not stand for what we stand for, yet she presumes to stand for what woman want. Our gender is hardly relevant at all to what threatens the nation and the liberties we want preserved and protected. The shame of institutionalized racism led a nation to yearn for the day when a black person could get elected president. But the color of one's skin does not open a window to the content of one's character, and so a president elected because of the color of his skin has only opened the nation's wounds to a festering point. What possible benefit can exist in electing a woman when we know all too painfully to be a congenital liar and incompetent?

As women, we have something to say about who gets elected. We want a leader who we can trust to lead America with strength, humility and character. (AFA won the lawsuit.) Later, Avi, who was also a travel magazine author, became my client handling some of his travel needs. Avi was also a good friend to Victoria Davis, who sat on AFA's board of directors, and others in this group. He will be greatly missed.

Final note - It has been a real pleasure and privilege to share the top spot with Victoria Davis this last year. Victoria has been a friend and a mentor and by her example has made it easier for me to carry on the duties in 2016. 

AVI DAVIS



At the end of December, we lost a true friend and ally to MBARWF. Avi Davis passed away on December 21st, 2015.

He was a true Renaissance man who contributed greatly to enlightening many about the perils that seem to be moving quickly throughout the world. His organization, American Freedom Alliance (AFA), was a truly unique operation that sponsored book lectures, movies, and speakers who educated us with knowledge of facts relating to current issues. JANUARY BOOK RECOMMENDATION

An Honorable, Moral Man's Handbook and A Good Girl's Handbook

Sexual morality and relationships can make or break someone's life. Most people have watched someone they know and love make a turn or decision that is guaranteed to result in needless suffering. However, saying something to the person in the hopes of providing them with an alternative can feel awkward and may even jeopardize a friendship or family rapport, so we don't do anything. I discovered two wonderful booklets that are short, sweet and to the point and that succeed in accomplishing exactly that. These two 48-page booklets, [An Honorable, Moral Man's Handbook](#) and [A Good Girl's Handbook](#), clearly explain the choices young men and women face, what roads lead where and tie these choices to American and Judeo-Christian values without being overly preachy. They can be purchased one at a time or in bulk, which is what I do. I carry some with me or mail them off to people who are interested. I've given out dozens to others who say they helped them make better choices. One of the best parts of each book is the "Dear Abby" type letters that cover life-altering subjects with no-nonsense advice and humor. Part of the reason the left has gotten so far promoting immorality is that it's easy for modest and reserved conservatives to avoid awkward or uncomfortable topics or, if we engage in them, to remain vague. They spell out in black and white what we know to be true in a way that can help redirect people who have been misled or flat out misinformed by promoters of promiscuity who present immorality as a form of male and female empowerment when virtue, character, integrity and honor in both men and women are the true source of empowerment.
