Robert was born and raised in Hungary, survived the Holocaust as a child, then escaped from Communism during the 1956 uprising. He was able to come to the freedom of the United States and became a proud American.

He became a dentist and served in the US Navy at the beginning of the Vietnam war, spending several months on Guam. After 9/11 he realized that the destructive and tyrannical Nazi and Communist ideologies from which he escaped were beginning to spread their venom and infiltrate the uninformed, freedom loving citizens of the US, especially the youth. He began to study the Koran to find out more about this so-called 'religion of peace', which killed more than 3000 Americans on our own soil, as well as many others all over the world.

Hold onto your seats for a fiction series that plays out a terrifying sequence of events in The Great and Terrible, Volumes 1-6 Hardcover Set by Chris Stewart. Several Electromagnetic Pulse bombs are set off over America crippling the country while diabolical super powers in the world have a viable plan to destroy America then slice and divvy the world up by resources between them. However, there are people put in place long before to foil these villains.
